So why not seek our local farmers' markets in Settle on the 2nd Sunday of every month, our village stores in both Austwick and Clapham, our local pub the Game Cock in Austwick village and the excellent award winning Home Barn café at the hamlet of Feizor this would make a real difference to these local businesses and our local rural community.
3. **Reduce, Reuse, Recycle** – support us in our efforts to reduce waste. Recycle bins are provided down the track towards the bunkhouses. Alternatively please do leave paper, bottles etc. beside your bins and we will recycle them.
4. **Switch off...and save energy** - in this beautiful, rural area you can see the stars at night! Help us reduce energy use and CO2 emissions by switching off lights and standby buttons when you don't need them. Help us reduce water consumption by using just the water you need.
5. **Follow the Countryside Code** – the countryside code reminds us all to protect, respect and enjoy: look after plants and animals; take litter away; leave gates and property as you find them; keep dogs under close control; and consider other people. All the fields and land surrounding Dalesbridge are privately owned, please respect and support our local farmers who farm it!
